

Modular testing

Every student enrolled on a course with us, except for examination courses, will be sent a modular test every four weeks in conjunction with the terms and modules laid out on our Academic calendar. The modular test is sent through an online testing platform called TestInvite, that both sends the tests to the individual students and tracks their progress.


The modular test assesses the student's progress throughout their course and follows their progress as they continue to progress through the levels. There is one test which is sent to all the students, but the questions are generated from a question bank that means that even though it is the same test, students will have different questions every time they complete it (See Appendix B and D). This helps us with tracking their progress more thoroughly. The teacher can then, access their scores on the platform (See appendix A) and take their progress into account when giving them their tutorials, which are also done in the same week, every four weeks.

The test involves multiple choice questions on vocabulary and grammar and then short reading and listening questions. It usually takes around 40 minutes, depending on the level of the student but there is a timer for 60 minutes just in case. The writing and speaking skills are assessed through their classes by the teachers through various activities.

The test is scored by individual points for every correct answer and then added up at the end, giving them an overall score (%) as well as scores for each section (Grammar/Vocabulary, Reading, Listening). To avoid cheating on the test, as it is done online, there are precautions taken place on the platform to ensure that the student cannot navigate away from the page without stopping the test altogether (See appendix C).




Appendix A – results page viewed by teachers






Appendix B – Test page viewed from students
