



Occupational English Test

The Occupational English Test (OET) is a test of English for healthcare professionals. Passing is accepted by the General Medical Council and Nursing and Midwifery Council as meeting their English Language requirements.

Healthcare professionals require a grade B in the OET to work in the UK. Grade B is an advanced level of English, equivalent to IELTS band 7 and C1 in the Common European Framework (CEF).

OET is focused completely on work-related language and scenarios, allowing candidates to access their existing professional knowledge.
